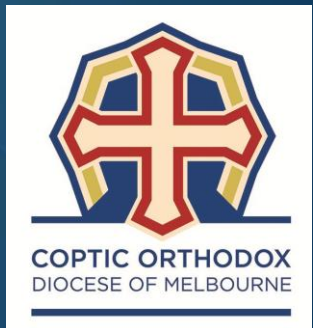

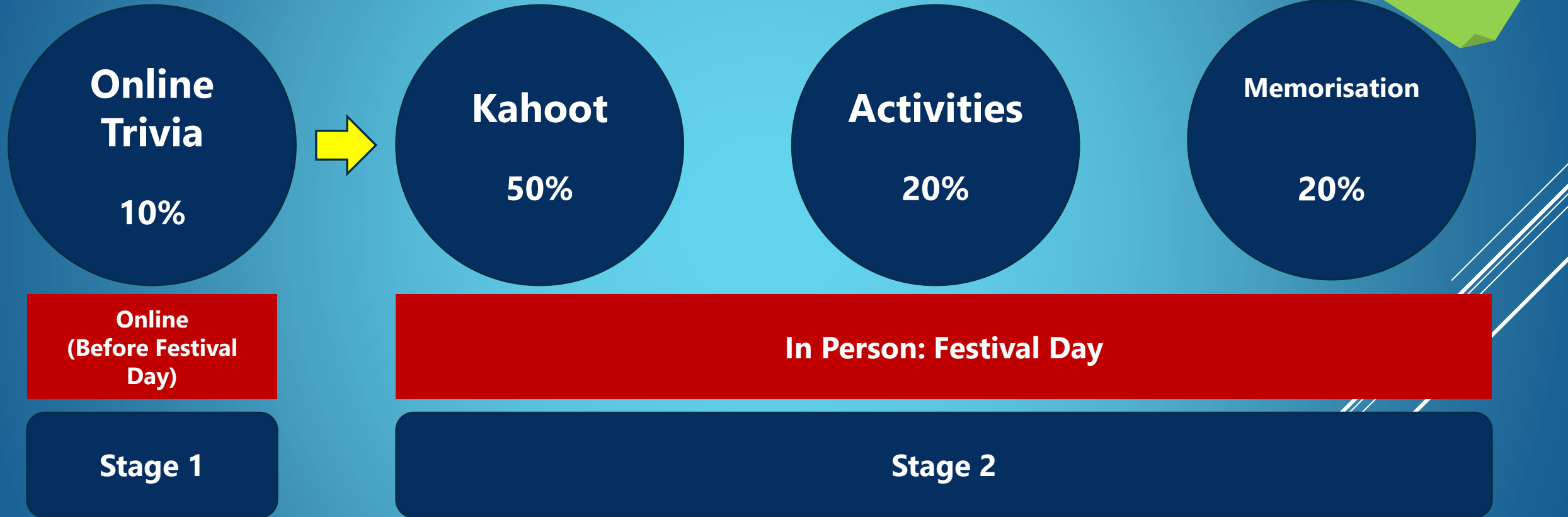

SPIRITUAL: GR 1-3

Participation Requirements:

- On the festival evaluation day:
 - **A Minimum attendance of 2 children per year level is required for Group A churches**
 - **A Minimum attendance of 5 children per year level is required for Group B churches**
- In case of the above criteria are not met:
 - **A 20% deduction per year level** will be applied to the total score for each year level that does not meet the criteria.
 - **For example,** if a Group B church participates in Year 1-3 spiritual component with:
 - 2 children in year 1
 - 8 children in year 2
 - 3 children in year 3

Their total score will be penalized by **40%** as they did not meet the criteria for year 1 and year 3



SPIRITUAL: GR 1-3 GUIDELINES

- **Updated:** Each church is allowed **TWO Servants** to attend with **Gr 1-3** on the SF day inside the evaluation room.
 - ▶ **Updated:** The church servant's role and responsibility will be limited to the following:
 - ▶ Help and support
of the children if any child need to go out or in from the evaluation for necessary circumstances
 - ▶ The church servant is kindly and respectfully not permitted
to intervene with the instructions and the role of the SF panel on the day
 - ▶ The church servant is allowed
to put the children in groups on the day **ONLY ONCE** and will not be changed once the evaluation starts.

SF committee is trying to encourage kids to enjoy the day and the festival with no pressure.



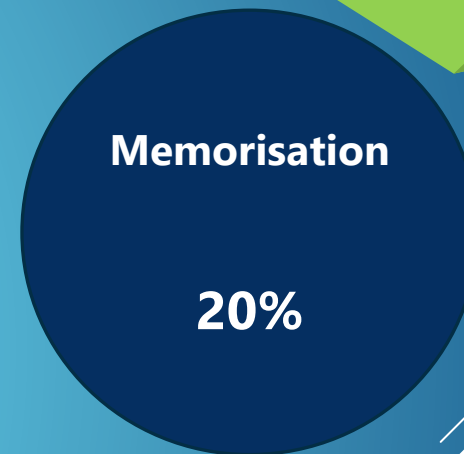
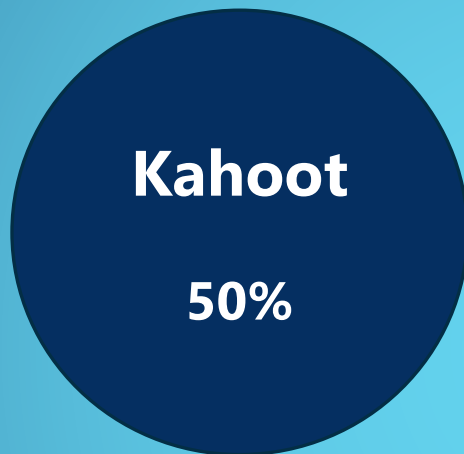

 - 4 children in year 4
 - 3 children in year 5
 - 8 children in year 6

Their total score will be penalized by **40%** as they did not meet the criteria for year 4 and year 5

Introduction

Faithful Minds is an interactive evaluation activity designed to engage grades 7 to 9 children in a fun and meaningful exploration of their faith. This evaluation encourages learning, discussion, and reflection through a light-hearted, competitive format.

NEW

Purpose

The primary purpose of this evaluation is to help grade 7 to 9 children evaluate and deepen their understanding of key concepts in the curriculum while fostering teamwork and a sense of unity among participants.

While the game incorporates competitive elements for the children's enjoyment, it is essential to emphasise that the competitive aspect is secondary to the learning experience.

Game Structure and Rules

Faithful Minds is structured to allow individual church groups to participate.

Interstate and overseas churches will participate as individual teams via Zoom, while in-person Victorian Churches will play the game as two churches teams (One Group A & Other from Group B).

The game will use a platform such as Quizizz as the platform for real-time answer submission and recording.

Rules

1. Both teams will answer the same questions, ensuring equal participation and fairness.
2. Questions may vary in nature; some questions will allow teams to submit short text answers, some multiple choice, and some fill-in-the-blank; all questions will need to be answered within a set time limit.

Rules

3. Once both teams have submitted their answers, all responses will be revealed to everyone for discussion.
 4. A member of the judging panel will assign points based on the quality and depth of each answer (according to model answers); it is important to note that these points do not directly correlate to each church's actual evaluation score and only serve as an indication.
- A Panel of judges will evaluate each church's question and answer in-depth afterwards according to a set and agreed-upon marking guide.



Rules

5. The primary aim is to promote learning, discussion, and collaboration, with the competitive aspect included solely for enjoyment.

Game Structure

- 1. Teams:** Each Church Group will form a team. Each team collaborates to answer questions on a laptop, tablet or phone.
- 2. Rounds:** The game is organised into themed rounds based on topics from the curriculum. Each round has 4–5 questions that increase in difficulty.

Game Structure

- 3. Scoring:** Teams earn points for correct answers, with potential bonus points for creativity, detailed answers, or insightful reflections.
- 4. Final Round:** "Lightening Round" with quicker, shorter questions.



Sample Rounds and Questions

Round 1: The Incarnation and Redemption

- ▶ **Sample Question:** "According to Coptic Orthodox teachings, why was it necessary for Jesus to incarnate as a human?"
- ▶ **Bonus:** Describe in your own words what "incarnation" means and why it matters to our faith.



Sample Rounds and Questions

Round 2: Church Teachings and Sacraments

- ▶ **Sample Question:** *"What are the four essential sacraments needed for salvation according to Coptic Orthodox faith?"*
- ▶ **Bonus:** *Explain one of the sacraments in detail (e.g., Baptism or Communion).*



Sample Rounds and Questions

Round 3: Church History and Heroes

- ▶ **Sample Question:** *"Who was Pope Athanasius, and why is he known as 'the Defender of the Faith'?"*
- ▶ **Bonus:** *Describe one challenge he faced and how he responded.*



Sample Rounds and Questions

Round 4: The Book of Exodus and God's Deliverance

- ▶ **Sample Question:** *"What is the symbolic meaning of the Ten Plagues in Exodus, particularly the last one?"*
- ▶ **Bonus:** *What lesson can we take from Moses' leadership in the Exodus story?*

Sample Rounds and Questions

Round 5: Walk in the Light

- ▶ **Sample Question:** *"In what ways can a believer be a 'light' to others according to church teachings?"*
- ▶ **Bonus:** *Share an example of a saint who embodied this idea of being a light.*



SPIRITUAL: GR 7-9 GUIDELINES

NEW

Possible Interactive Elements:

Picture Round: Icons or illustrations of saints, key biblical moments, or symbols (like the cross or the burning bush) are shown for teams to identify or discuss their meanings

Mystery Quote: Significant verses or sayings are read, and teams reflect on its significance (e.g., “The Lord is my light and my salvation” - Psalm 27:1)

"Fill in the Blanks": For quotes or key doctrinal statements, teams fill in missing words (e.g., "I am the _____ of the world" - "light")

Reflection Round: A reflective question where teams share personal insights or applications related to the topics discussed



SPIRITUAL: GR 7-9 GUIDELINES

NEW

- For this Age Group **NO Servants are permitted** to go inside the evaluation room on the SF day.
- Churches are **not required** to group the children in advance and that will be **the role of the SF Panel on the day**. This is based on previous years experience across all churches and children. This is to allow and encourage kids to enjoy the day and the festival. Also, this is to take off the concept of competition and pressure.

- **CONTENT (50%):** Includes the actual material which has been studied and explored and the additional research which was added with other references and resources to build on the provided curriculum. Integration of the curriculum topics and how they encompass the over-arching theme will be highly regarded
- **PRESENTATION MEDIUM (30%):** This is the method of communication to articulate the findings, research and learnings. This can be but not limited to technology presentation, 3D model, poster, video, short interview or any other new creative medium. You may use more than one medium
- **TEAMWORK (20%):** This includes the method and professionalism of how the group worked together to achieve the presented outcomes. Maximum involvement and participation from each age group of each church is highly considered and encouraged

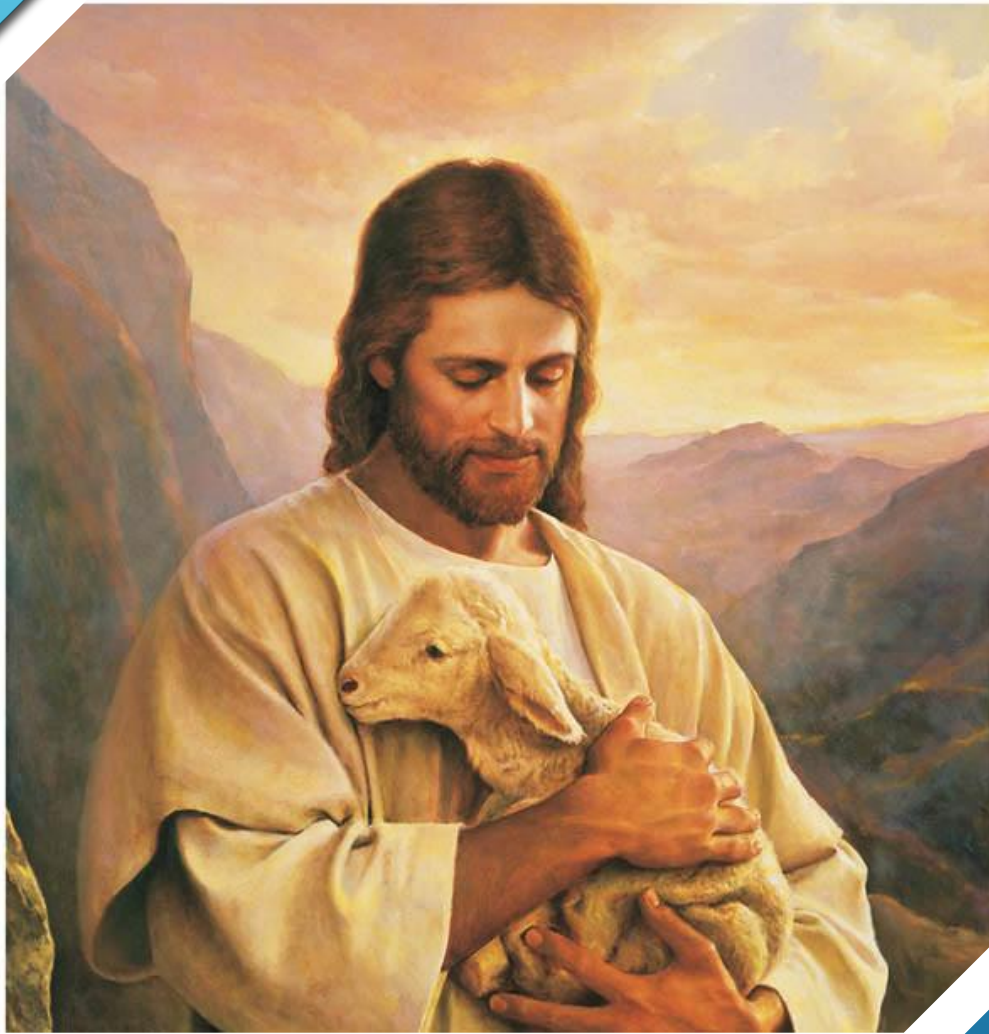
