Age Group

Participants can be from the following age groups:

- 1. Angels
- 2. Primary (Grade 1-6)
- 3. Secondary (Year 7-12)
- 4. Youth Age (18 25 years old)
- 5. Adults Age (25+ years old)

Note: **Grade 1** age groups is floating. This means - as a church; you can choose for **Grade 1** to join either angels or primary choirs.

Entry Limit

Registration is limited to one team per age group from each church (depends on restrictions, same church with same age group may split into 2 teams to accommodate max number of children. please refer to Competition Format)

There are no limits for individual performances participation, everyone is welcome. However, the committee advocates participants who have genuine interest.

Fee Payments

Please refer to summer festival main website for detailed information on registration fees and payments.

Competition Format

- There are four categories of performances that each church can participate in:
 - Choir Groups
 - Individual vocal performances (Normal Level, Advanced Level*)
 Only one person to perform to show his/her talent.
 - ➤ Instrumental performances (Normal Level, Advanced Level*)
 Up to three instrument performers can perform together to show their talents
 - ➤ Ensemble Performance
 A team of 4 to 9 members with mixed instrumental lines (may include vocal lines) to perform together

Due to uncertainty of the COVID pandemic, we have introduced different format options for the Competition based on the restrictions at the time.

❖ Option-1:

- In the circumstance where there are restrictions on gatherings, and no possibility of choir to practice or to perform as a group, the choir participants will need to record a selected hymn, each on their own at home. Scoring of the choir will be based on the average of all the choir team members
- Each choir member will record a video singing the motto and one Verse of a pre-selected Hymn within 3 mins time.

❖ Option-2:

- In the event where NO live stage performance can go ahead.
- Choir teams have the chance to meet and record a video of their performance. Stage like area has to be setup please refer to 'General video recommendations for video recorded performances' section.
- Choir groups with a larger number of participants than the allowed to gather at time on restrictions may choose to split into 2 teams (in that case, no choir member is allowed to participate in both teams of same age group)
- In case of splitting teams, scoring will be based on the average. Same music can be used in both performances.
- It is accepted, but not recommended, to have the same vocal soloist between the two teams, if no other member can fill same purpose.
- Committee expects to see SAME Performance done by both teams. Not a different one for each team.

^{*}Based on Vocal/Instrumental performance score, participants may be invited to participate in advanced level. Advanced performance is not added to the church overall score. However, the participants will receive an individual appreciation award.

Option-3:

- In the event where live stage performance may go ahead. Audience attendance will depend on restrictions at the time of the performance.
- Limitations on number of members per choir might be required, pending the restrictions at the time.
- Choir groups with larger number of participants than allowed at the time of restrictions will have to record a video instead of attending stage performance OR split into 2 teams (in that case, no choir member is allowed to participate in both teams of same age group).
- In case of splitting teams, scoring will be based on the average. Same music can be used in both performances. It is accepted, but not recommended, to have the same vocal soloist between the two teams, if no other member can fill same purpose.
- Committee expects to see SAME Performance done by both teams. Not a different one for each team

Important Notes:

- Choirs groups should not be less than 5 members
- Summer Festival Committee on behalf of the Coptic orthodox Diocese of Melbourne does not take responsibility for teams or participants that does not follow their local governmental instructions in relation of COVID-19 restrictions. It is solely subject to teams' Admins and leaders to insure the safe practice for all participants. Please choose the right option that suits your team circumstances in light of the local relevant restrictions
- Penalties or possible disqualification may occur if rules of your local Government have not been met

^{*}If you exceed the times above, then a deduction of 1% of the total mark per each extra minute will be applied

^{*}Motto is NOT mandatory for Angel choirs. However, Angels' teams may choose motto as one of their selected hymns

General Instructions

- Each church must provide the committee with Contact details of one contact person/leader responsible for the co-ordination of tasks between the committee and the church and any other questions. and up to 4 age coordinators - to help with registrations and online submission (Angel coordinator, Primary coordinator, Secondary coordinator, Adult and Youth coordinator). Committee will not be coordinating with multiple leaders.
- 2. Instructions on how to submit Lyrics and Hymns will be provided on the summer festival main website. Submission should adhere to mentioned deadlines.
- 3. Approved languages for choir festival are only **English**, **Arabic**, **Coptic** and **Fijian**.

The committee is encouraging the production of new hymns written and composed by our talented people. All lyrics submission <u>MUST</u> be reviewed, approved and <u>SIGNED</u> by the church priest with the priest contact details to be provided to the committee

All Lyrics and Hymns submission MUST include the following:

Church name
Age group
Responsible leader name and contact details
Choir team's Name – if any

And for each Hymn:

New lyrics author name Hymn source Music Composer Vocal Soloist Live Instrument Soloist

Important note: Failure to communicate this info to the committee before assigned due date may result in not evaluating your efforts producing lyrics or music.

If there is a feedback by the committee, the responsible leader will be contacted to amend the lyrics and hymns and it needs to be sent back by the deadline mentioned

- 4. **Strictly, no acting is permitted**. Narration is allowed between hymns if the purpose is to link an idea in the performance
- 5. During stage performances, it is important that we respect each other and remain silent. Marks will be deducted from the team causing distraction while choirs are performing

Interstate Performances

- ❖ Interstate performances will be allocated time to present their recorded performance to the committee and the general audience through live stream on YouTube. The performances will not be played on stage due to limited stage time availability. The audio and video quality must be clear. The committee will preview the recorded performance and if the quality is not clear enough, then the performance will be assessed in a closed room and not be live streamed.
- All participants must be seen within camera shooting width including team conductor, live musicians and other servants involved. If any member participating in the performance is not seen in the video, the relevant scoring for that individual will not be considered. Example, if the live musicians are not in the video, they will not be scored as per criteria.
- A setup of a stage-like area with either, the church alters or just white background is mandatory for all performances.
- The church must submit one video with the full performance for each of the age groups participating. A video per each hymn is not accepted
- ❖ For fair judgment of your performance, please use stage equipment setup not media-controlled setup. The ability to add effects or edit recorded audio in any way is not acceptable
- Committee members are happy to provide help over the phone if needed. Kindly advise your recording date one week in advance, so we make ourselves available to help with setup for your recording. We will not listen to your performance we will not give hints on your performance. We can only help producing good quality video.
- Performance should be filmed solely for the summer festival. No previous recorded performance from church/team's library would be accepted

Choir Guidelines and Scoring Criteria

- ❖ The main Motto of the summer festival should be presented **AT THE START OF** your performance.
- The motto time is NOT included in your performance time but it will be assessed as per attached assessment guidelines. (Except for angels' choir Motto is not compulsory)
- Your performance should not exceed assigned preparation/performance time. Please refer to competition format
- Please stick to your submitted and approved Lyrics unless otherwise have been advised to you by Committee Members.

Vocal / instrumental Scoring Criteria

- ❖ The main Motto of the summer festival should NOT be presented prior your performance.
- Your performance should not exceed assigned preparation/performance time. Please refer to competition format
- While submission of lyrics for Vocal performances are NOT required, participants should insure the chosen lyrics comply with our Coptic Orthodox Faith
- Audio tracks can accompany vocal performance but the track will not be evaluated; only the vocal. So please make the track simple to just provide guidance and not to cover-up the soloist.
- Audio tracks <u>shall not</u> accompany Instrumental performances.
- As further clarification, Vocal individuals cannot be a duet. Only one person per performance. Instrumental performance can team up to max of three instruments.
- ❖ Hymn chosen for performance needs to be within Orthodox faith.

Ensemble Scoring Criteria

A team of 4 to 9 members with mixed instrumental lines (may include Vocal Lines) to perform together for up to 7 minutes stage time with 3 minutes stage preparation.

- Minimum 3 texture line should be presented
- ❖ If vocal lines are included, vocal performers should be 4 or less. The lyrics must be submitted for approval by due date outlined in main guidelines.
- ❖ Key technical points each team should take into consideration:
 - Musical Structure
 - Melody: pitch, duration, tempo ...
 - Harmony: chord, progression, consonance/dissonance, key, tonality/ atonality
 - Music Dynamics
 - Instruments' Timbre match
 - Texture/musical lines

General video recommendations for video recorded performances

- For sound clarity, it is highly recommended to have the audio input through microphones or audio system and inserted to camera audio input.
- Choose a quiet time and place to record as background noise will be heard in the background and will reduce the sound quality of the video.
- Try to choose a location with no tiles, marble or laminated wooden floors as this will cause echoing in the sound of the video. Carpet flooring is highly recommended.
- choir members should not move while shooting the video Trying to keep same distance away from audio input device throughout the whole recording
- The recorded video must be sent as raw recording, without any video or audio editing
- Performance should be filmed solely for the summer festival. No previous recorded performance from church/team's library will be accepted

Performance Day important instructions

- We ask that you kindly make yourself available on time recommended to arrive 30mins prior your first performance.
- Kindly be Punctual. Come on time, prepare on time, perform on time and leave stage on time. Every minute delayed means deduction of your score.
- There will not be a chance to access the venue for final rehearsals on stage. In addition, audio systems will not be available except on performance days. Please send us your Audio requirements if any, so that we can support it.
- On the performance day, you are all welcome to meet with the committee members within break time. However, the committee members <u>should not</u> be approached during or between performances
- ❖ We are all servants, here to serve God's sons and daughters. So, be a role model. No aggression will be tolerated with any churches members or with the judging committee. Aggression may lead to score deduction or possible disqualification.
- Six pamphlets of the performance should be provided to the committee on the day (softcopy is enough for recorded performances). Pamphlets must have a cover page that includes church name, age group, responsible leader contact details, name of new lyrics author, name of music player/composer, and name of soloist of each hymn.

N.B, if any info you have previously missed to communicate to the committee (like new lyrics owner, songwriter, music composer, songs in order etc.) kindly include it in your on the day submitted pamphlets.

- Once a performance is called in for preparation, timer will appear on a side screen to let you know how much time left for you to get started.
- ❖ A side projector will be available for power point presentation, in case needed.
- ❖ Deduction WILL happen if anything happens by one of your team members that may lead to any disturbance on the day. For example, Noise or distraction while others are performing, aggression, not following instruction from servants, as well as late attendance or performance time/ preparation time exceeded etc.
- Choir performances will be on live streaming on Facebook Summer Festival page as well as on YouTube. Please let us know if you have any concerns
