Each participant will receive an award according to their achievement in the Technology and IT component of the Summer Festival. Accordingly, there will be a registration fee as follows:

General Guidelines for All Age Groups

1. The IT project mark will be a percentage of the overall spiritual component.
2. All projects **MUST** be submitted online through the SF online registration system by providing a link to the project “either Google drive or Microsoft drive or Dropbox etc” by the deadline mentioned above.

NO submission will be accepted After the Deadline.

3. Your submission must include a document showing the church name, age group, group name, members' names, everyone's role in the project, project description, actual time spent on the project for completion (days, hours, ...etc) and programs used in developing the project.
4. You can participate in as an Individual or as a Team.
5. All projects must be in compliance with only the offered options and formats described later on in this document for each age group whether it is an individual project or a team project.
6. We recommend that servants encourage everyone to either provide an individual project or work in a team and get more professional project done.

7. Servant Participation:

- a. Please remember that this component is intended to foster the creativity and technical ability of the participant(s). The servants should encourage the participants' creativity and not give any technical input to the programs being used in the development of the project.
8. All Projects must be the original work of the participants and should reflect his/her/their creative ability. Plagiarism is strictly prohibited and will negatively affect your mark.
 9. If your church is participating with a team project, then the project should be represented by one or more members of the team.
 10. **Important:** Each participant is only allowed to participate in **ONE and ONLY ONE submission.**
 11. The church can have more than one submission either an individual or a team work.
 - a. If there is more than one submission representing the church, then the highest mark will be taken in count.

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12. All resources used should be consistent with our Coptic orthodox beliefs, whether images, movies, music, or any other information. All references should be included in the submission.

(Note: We recommend that your servant review the theological content beforehand.)

13. **On the presentation day**, please bring your laptop and any other required accessories like (mouse, keyboard, speakers, etc) in order to perform the presentation.

14. **On the presentation day**, participant(s) must explain the role on the project and how participated in achieving it.

15. **On the presentation day**, the panel of judges will mark the submission and higher marks will be given to the most professional and complex projects.

16. Top winning submission will be presented in the celebration ceremony.

Evaluation Criteria

a- **Ideas & Sources:** you have to provide all the sources and references used for the project and other ideas you have come up with it to do your project.

b- **Project Plan:** what is your plan that you put together to implement the project

c- **Implementation & Complexity:** how is the project implemented, tools and software being used, how long does it take, efforts, how complex is the project and the complexity of the technology behind it.

d- **Quality & user friendly:** For desktop, web or mobile application, the code has to be error free with no defects and final product should be a user friendly. For infographic projects, that will be the quality of the style and template used to design it, and how clear it is for others to read and understand.

e- **Completeness:** percentage of the completeness of the final product

f- Productivity / Effectiveness / Impressive Technology Presentation:

- You have to show how the final product is effective and practical to the real life in church services, and which benefits will your product add to the service. It will be also good to show if the final product will help in increasing the productivity of a service in the church.
- The most impressive technology presentation of the final product will gain more points.

g- Presentation: presentation skills of the presenter, responses to questions and demonstrated knowledge of the project.

The work should focus on one of the following topics:

- a. Create an informative video about the sacrament of the “Holy Matrimony”.
- b. Design an infographic video about " The Lord in my Light and My Salvation" guided by a character that embodies the essence of joy, considering the selection of only one character or one of the topics of the 2023 Summer Festival.
- c. Create an explainer video to display “The Lord in my Light and My Salvation” from the festival theme.
- d. Design an explainer video about “candles and oil lamps” and their use in the Coptic Orthodox Church.
- e. Create a promo of the Festival theme "The Lord in my Light and My Salvation" without filming, for a duration not exceeding 30 seconds, using any suitable video design software.

Team Submission Format (Grade 10-12) and (Youth & Adults 30+ Ages)

Please choose one of the following projects:

1- Programming competition

The team projects allow more space for creativity and imagination. Also, it aims towards providing a solution to some of the obstacles that we face in our services in the church that can be solved by using the technology to make it more efficient and beneficial to whom are going to use it.

This can be a web application (needs programming), desktop app or a mobile app

The team should have minimum of 4 members:

- **Designer:** a member who is responsible for everything that is related to the graphics design and user design interface for the application
- **Developer:** a member who is responsible for programming and coding the application and the database
- **Coordinator:** a member who is responsible for collecting all the required information and contents for the application, testing the application and performing quality checks on the final product
- **Marketer:** a member who is responsible for doing a marketing campaign about the idea of the application, its benefits and how useful it is for the users. Also spreading the application between people in an innovative way

Project Ideas:

Please find a solution for one of the following obstacles using technology either by creating an advanced web application or mobile application:

- Lots of people in the church congregation sometimes they find it difficult to know the timetable for the liturgies in other churches and monasteries across the diocese. Please find a solution that allows people to find the nearest church to their location and liturgy timetable, so they can attend a liturgy there by showing the church or monastery address/location
- Sunday School & Youth servants always find difficulty in finding places that are suitable for camps and excursions according to the age group that they are serving. Please find a solution that can help servants in that issue

The above are just two examples, but you may come up with another idea for an issue and its solution. It is very important in this team project to provide a documented evidence and feedback about the application either in writing or video recording for at least 5 users whom were facing the issue and how the application gave them a solution for it and they got a benefit out of it.
