

SPIRITUAL: GR 1-3

Participation Requirements:

- On the festival evaluation day:
 - A Minimum attendance of 2 children per year level is required for Group A churches
 - A Minimum attendance of 5 children per year level is required for Group B churches
- In case of the above criteria are not met:
 - A 20% deduction per year level will be applied to the total score for each year level that does not meet the criteria.
 - For example, if a Group B church participates in Year 1-3 spiritual component with:
 - 2 children in year 1
 - 8 children in year 2
 - 3 children in year 3

Their total score will be penalized by 40% as they did not meet the criteria for year 1 and year 3





SPIRITUAL: GR 1-3 GUIDELINES

- This year SF will allow ONLY ONE Servant from each church to attend with Gr 1-3 on the SF day inside the evaluation room.
 - ► The church servant's role and responsibility will be limited to help and support of the children if any child need to go out or in from the evaluation for necessary circumstances.
 - ► The church servant is kindly and respectfully not permitted to intervene with the instructions and the role of the SF panel on the day,
- Churches are **not required** to group the children in advance and that will be the role of the SF Panel on the day.

This is based on previous years experience across all churches and children. This is to allow and encourage kids to enjoy the day and the festival. Also, this is to take off the concept of competition and pressure.

SPIRITUAL: GR 4-6

Participation Requirements:

- On the festival evaluation day:
 - A Minimum attendance of 2 children per year level is required for Group A churches
 - A Minimum attendance of 5 children per year level is required for Group B churches
- In case of the above criteria are not met:
 - A 20% deduction per year level will be applied to the total score for each year level that does not meet the criteria.
 - For example, if a Group B church participates in Year 4-6 spiritual component with:
 - 4 children in year 4
 - 3 children in year 5
 - 8 children in year 6

Their total score will be penalized by 40% as they did not meet the criteria for year 4 and year 5

SPIRITUAL: GR 7-9 GUIDELINES

- For this Age Group **NO Servants are permitted** to go inside the evaluation room on the SF day.
- Churches is **not required** to group the children in advance and that will be **the role of the SF Panel on the day**. This is based on previous years experience across all churches and children. This is to allow and encourage kids to enjoy the day and the festival. Also, this is to take of the concept of competition and pressure.

- This year SF will move to a new way of reviewing and presenting the learned content of the spiritual component
- Rather than a Q&A session within the age group, a presentation or activity style forum will be used to evaluate the learnings
- SF hope that this will remove the pressure from our children in memorising pages and pages of content. This will allow our children to learn in a fun, comfortable and non-invasive environment
- The role of the servant is to facilitate the learnings of the topics and allow the children to design creative ways to depict their learning experience

- The structure of the presentation for the visiting church will be as following:
 - **5min** prayer
 - 45min session 1 (up to 3 topics)
 - **20min** aghapy/break
 - **45min** session 2 topics (up to 3 topics)
 - **5min** conclusion
- The **visiting church** will spend **a maximum of 2 hours** at the hosting church.
 - Depending on the number of topics the visiting church will be presenting (15min per topic).
 - For example if a church is presenting 2 topics only (30min), then the whole visit will be 1hr including topic presentation, break/aghapy, prayer and conclusion.
- Each church will visit another church
- The host church will welcome a visiting church and present the SF topics with an activity or presentation





- Within the new Expo/Fun Day, each group will be assessed according to the three criteria below
- A SF committee panel will be present at the host church to review with a feedback survey for the visiting church to fill in also
- CONTENT (40%): This is the pitch of the group and the message which is being relayed. This should also include the learnings, outcomes and achievements discovered by the group
- PRESENTATION (40%): This is the method of communication to articulate understanding and learnings. This can be but not limited to technology. Try to be creative and engaging, with forums such as activitivies, puzzles and escape rooms etc. You may use more than one medium
- PARTICIPATION (20%): This includes the method and professionalism of how the group worked together to achieve the presented outcomes. Maximum involvement and participation from each age group of each church is highly considered and encouraged

SPIRITUAL: YOUTH (19-29 YEARS OLD)







- SF moved for last 2 years to a new way of reviewing and presenting the learned content of the spiritual component. Rather than a Q&A session with the age groups in question an expo style forum (or project delivery) will be used to evaluate the comprehension of each group
- The idea would be that each group read and comprehend the content within the provided booklet. Using this curriculum and themes as guidelines, the expectation would be that further research from other literature and resources be used to visualise learnings in a free and creative way

- Within the new Expo/Fun Day, each group will be assessed according to the three criteria below
- CONTENT (50%): Includes the actual material which has been studied and explored and
 the additional research which was added with other references and resources to build on
 the provided curriculum. This is the pitch of the group and the message which is being
 relayed. This should also include the learnings, outcomes and achievements discovered
 by the group. Integration of the curriculum topics and how they encompass the overarching theme will be highly regarded
- PRESENTATION MEDIUM (30%): This is the method of communication to articulate the findings, research and learnings. This can be but not limited to technology presentation, 3D model, poster, video, short interview or any other new creative medium. You may use more than one medium
- TEAMWORK (20%): This includes the method and professionalism of how the group worked together to achieve the presented outcomes. Maximum involvement and participation from each age group of each church is highly considered and encouraged
